**DAY 1, 28 December 2017**

Zonal Reports of every zones were presented by the respective Zonal Presidents. Lack of events other than ZNC was questioned to the Zonal Council. Proposals for conducting small scale events were put forward by the General Council as a part of the NASA day.

Session started off with EASA presentation by the treasurer. The process of applying for it was discussed. The completion of the logo being registered was brought into the GCs notice and the process behind it was also explained. Later 60<sup>th</sup> year subscription fee statistics were put forward to the GC. Vice president briefed about the website and the status of Publications. Presentations were made by ZP6 on TPS and PR on NASA India Portfolio. Branding Manager bids were presented for handling Association's social media.

The session started with Trophy discussion. The concerns not properly scanned sheets were raised by the EC. Voting for dropping the G-sen workshop was passed. Introduction of trophy design competition was passed by the GC. Amendment of the constitution for applying for 12 80G and registered under society's Act was mentioned.

The ANDC jury criteria were mentioned. Proceedings regarding Internship forum and ways to boost its outreach was discussed. 67 Top ANDC entries were announced.

## **DAY 2, 29 December 2017**

GC voted for the submission of delegation numbers for ANC by the end of the day. This was done to get a rough estimate of the delegation fee and considering the limitations of the host college.

The notion for introducing college of the year ranking based on Reubens results was passed by all zones except zone 2. Reubens was considered because all colleges do not attempt all trophies.

Campus tour happened at the end of the session.

Discussion on the format of the convention happened. The issue of keynotes and talks not being attended was raised by the executive council. The ratio 60% of crowd being occupied with workshops was passed by the GC. The presentations on the workshops was presented.

Presentation on talks, cultural events and informal events were presented by the volunteers. The issues related to Transport to the host college was discussed. 3 options were provided for transport.

1. Collecting students from Ernakulam railway station
2. Providing only drop after ANC

Travel option one was passed by the GC. Presentation regarding the food and its budget was presented. Accommodation per room was discussed and discussion happened about the delegate limit. 3000 was the limit voted by the GC.

## **DAY 3, 30 December 2017**

The call for having HOD seal and signature in each sheet and reports for Ruebens was taken. The guidelines for Ruebens was also discussed followed by discussion on nominations for the 61<sup>st</sup> year council. Presentation of the budget was done by the convenor. Scrutinising of the budget happened and decisions to remove pillows, installations, pergolas etc were taken to cut down the budget.

Delegate fee of 5500 and faculty fee of 700 was voted by the GC.
