

## LOUIS-I-KAHN Trophy FAQs Set 1

1. Can we document structures preserved under the ASI?

**Yes.**

2. Can we document a structure in which the semi-sacred space is connected to the core sacred space or is a part of the main building complex? In such a case do we have to document the core sacred space also?

**No need to document the core, unless some essential issues have to be mentioned. Only the semi-sacred work would be considered by the Jury.**

3. Do we also have to document the sacred building?

**NO.**

4. Can the semi sacred has to specifically belong to the religions mentioned or it can be based on spirituality?

**Can belong to any mode of considering sacred – religion, spirituality, retreat, place of discourses or meditation.**

5. Can we take a site currently not in use?

**Yes.**

6. Is a building of religious association in the past, with a change in functionality to an institutional building in the current scenario, eligible to be documented?

**The building to be documented should be semi-sacred in nature, even if not in use now. It should not have been adaptively reused as an institution, college, housing, restaurant or an office etc.**

7. Submission requirements second point (building and construction details measured drawings) and field notebooks first point are confusing. so please explain them individually.

**The two A1 Field Notes Panels (Building and Construction Details Measured Drawings) should contain field notes depicting the measuring process.**

**All remaining fieldnotes including sketches and hand drawn drawings shall be presented as supplement to formal documentation in form of a notebook.**
